Papua New Guinea is a country of wild beauty of breathtaking landscapes, of fascinating flora and fauna. Known as the “Land of a Thousand Cultures” there are well over 700 distinct languages spoken throughout the country. It is a place of drama, solitude and sophistication, recognised internationally as the last frontier.

The country is a vast and sensationally beautiful destination for adventure travellers. The legendary Kokoda Track is the primary line, across the rugged Owen Stanley Ranges, between the northern and southern coastlines of the country. The Track was the scene of bitter fighting during World War II and still contains the scars of many of the desperate battles that raged across it.

The Kokoda Track is by far the most popular trek in Papua New Guinea and takes between 6-9 days to walk depending on your fitness level. It is a challenge and the difficulty of the track should not be underestimated. As we are a Kokoda based company our treks are led by experienced PNG guides from the township of Kokoda and surrounding areas.

Kokoda Adventure



The days include river crossing, steep and gradual ascends and descends. The 96 kilometer trek is mainly through rain forests. Usually conditions are wet and slippery as rain can be expected on most days. Temperatures range from 24-30 degrees Celsius during the day and 16-24 degrees Celsius at night.

This track was made famous during WW11 and still bares the scars of a fierce campaign. For those of you who had loved ones fighting in PNG during WW11, this walk can be a very spiritual and emotional experience. Trekking in mud up to your knees and tricky river crossings indicate exactly the conditions under which our diggers fought.

For you our trekkers who are embarking on this Kokoda adventure, you will be assured of the most spectacular scenery and have an unforgettable experience. The local people in Kokoda and the Koiari's on the track are friendly and generous. Our food and personal porters are predominately from the Oro Province but also hire from other areas.
